In each of the following examples, only one of the three sentences is correct. Which one?

1)

a) It's warm in this room, so I will put off my jacket.

b) The CEO has put the meeting off until next month.

c) We have to put off the cover of the device in order to exchange the batteries.

2)

a) We have complained the last delivery because of faulty parts.

b) We have complained our supplier because of faulty parts in the last delivery.

c) We have complained to our supplier about faulty parts in the last delivery.

3)

a) We have agreed to bring forward the next delivery.

b) We have agreed bringing forward the next delivery.

c) We have agreed with bringing forward the next delivery.

4)

a) Yesterday I implemented a spare part to the old injection-moulding machine.

b) Last year we successfully implemented our CRM project.

c) Next month we will implement two new engineers to our R&D team in Munich.

5)

a) I really estimate the good work my colleague has done.

b) I estimate we will need 14 working days to do this task.

c) I estimate that this will be a very good supplier for us.
